As an electrical inspector, you are driven to positively impact electrical safety. You are responsible for inspecting electrical installations from start to finish, including: examining electrical drawings and inspecting installations to ensure electrical code compliance, advising customers, creating and maintaining inspection records, and investigating and reporting on electrical fires and accidents.

We administer and enforce Ontario's electrical safety regulations through the delivery of a wide range of services and initiatives that are supported by our safety stakeholders.
