

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?



LICENSED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING BUSINESS - MASTER ELECTRICIAN - CERTIFIED ELECTRICIAN

They may be easy to mix up, but they're quite different from each other. In Ontario, only a Licensed Electrical Contracting business can be hired to do electrical work in your home. No exceptions.

LICENSED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING BUSINESSES

- Have an ECRA/ESA licence number that proves they can operate as an electrical contracting business in Ontario.
- Their ECRA/ESA number should appear on their vehicles, business cards and estimates. Ask to see it.



MASTER ELECTRICIANS

- Work for Licensed Electrical Contracting Businesses to manage the work of Certified Electricians.
- Cannot be hired directly to do electrical work in your home.
- Have a Master Electrician licence number, which is not an ECRA/ESA licence.

In Ontario, only a Licensed Electrical Contracting business can be hired to do electrical work in your home. No exceptions.



CERTIFIED ELECTRICIANS

- Work for Licensed Electrical Contracting Businesses and cannot be hired directly to do electrical work in your home.
- Have a Skilled Trades Ontario certification number, which is not the same as an ECRA/ESA licence.
