

Frequently Asked Questions – Amendments to Ontario Regulation 570/05

1. What updates have been made to the Licensing Regulation?

The amendments to the Licensing Regulation will not affect ESA's licensing administration or processes. For the most part, the updates are related to general clean-up of the regulation references and clarifications.

The following updates have been made to the licensing regulation:

- Removal of references to the now out of date provisional licensing requirements
- Corrected errors in the regulation
- Clarified existing licensing requirements
- Aligned the regulation with other laws including the *Electricity Act*
- The proposed changes will not affect ESA's licensing administration or processes

2. What impact will these changes have on licensees?

The proposed changes will not affect Licensees' or ESA's licensing administration or processes. All licensing requirements remain the same. The majority of the changes involve the removal of references to the now out-of-date provisional licensing requirements. MGCS also took this opportunity to correct any errors in the regulation, clarify existing licensing requirements and align the regulation with other laws including the *Electricity Act*.
