Invoice Ceilings on ACP Small Jobs Are Being Raised

Effective April 6th, the Small Job invoice value limits are being increased. For Residential and Commercial/Industrial Small Jobs the installation value invoiced to the customer includes labour and materials; for HVAC installations it includes labour and miscellaneous materials (the value of the appliance and associated non-electrical equipment is excluded).

New Invoice Ceilings:

- Residential Small Job ≤ \$750
- Residential HVAC Small Job ≤ \$750
- C/I Small Job 1:10 tier ≤ \$750
- C/I Small Job 1:5 tier \$751 - \$2500
- C/I Small Job 1:3 tier \$2501 - \$5500

Please note that for Commercial/Industrial Small Jobs, the quantities for new devices and replacement devices for each tier remain the same.

Work in the Common Areas only of an Apartment Building

Effective April 6th, if work is being done in the common areas only of an existing apartment building (no work within any of the units) and the scope of work qualifies as a Commercial/Industrial Small Job it can be filed as a C/I Small Job. For example:

- Receptacle in lobby for TV monitor
- Outdoor receptacle
- 4 maglocks

Invoice ceiling or device quantities for each tier apply.

High Voltage Substation Maintenance and Low Voltage Service Maintenance

Low Voltage Service Maintenance is not included in an application filed for High Voltage Substation Maintenance. If maintenance is done on the HV Substation and the LV Service during the outage, by the same Contractor or by two different Contractors, two applications must be filed. The HV maintenance is filed under the HV Substation Maintenance vertical; the LV maintenance is filed under the Commercial / Industrial vertical.

New Code Training and OESC 26th Edition / 2015 Code Book

ALL ACP Contractors are required to attend ESA New Code training or take the New Code on-line course.
