Ontario Electrical Safety Code 26th edition / 2015 Effective May 5, 2016

As outlined in the ACP Manual ACP:

- Whenever the OESC Code Book is updated it is mandatory that the current issue be purchased. ESA recommends that sufficient copies be purchased so a current Code Book is readily available to all staff.
- ESA new Code Training is mandatory for all ACP members at each Code cycle; ACP Contractors must ensure that all staff doing electrical installations under ACP receive training on each New Code.

Code Books, which include the Bulletins, are now available. This year, ESA has partnered with CSA Group to offer the Code Book and all ESA bulletins – which provide important updates and interpretations – together for one price and at a significantly reduced rate from prior years. The Code will be available in print for \$219 or a searchable, digital format for \$195 – accessible on smart phones, tablets and desktops and compatible with Windows and iOS.

ESA is offering **training courses** to provide the electrical industry with an overview of new and amended requirements of the OESC (26th Edition). ESA is offering General Level 1, General Level 2 and HVAC Installations courses both in the classroom and through computer based training in an online learning environment.

General – Level 1

- Review the new and amended requirements of the General Sections of the OESC for Residential, Commercial and Industrial installations

General – Level 2

- Review the new and amended requirements of the Supplementary and Amendatory Sections of the OESC for Institutional, Commercial and Industrial installations.

HVAC Installations

- Covers OESC requirements for residential heating, ventilation & air conditioning equipment

The registration window for General Level 1 and General Level 2 on-line courses will open Tuesday, March 1; the window for the HVAC Installations course will open later in March (exact date TBD).
