OESC (24th Edition/2009) – TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR HVAC CONTRACTORS

ESA is offering an Ontario Electrical Safety Code (OESC) HVAC Specific training workshop to provide the HVAC industry with an overview of “key changes” to the OESC. This training will be facilitated by ESA Inspectors who have been specifically trained on the Code changes and can provide clarification on compliance requirements.

To address the specific needs of our HVAC Customers, we have created a training session that targets the HVAC industry. This training contains:

- New code changes specific to this line of business,
- Includes correct installations based on defects that are commonly issued on this type of work,
- PLUS provides the HVAC installer with step by step instructions for safe installations.

OESC Training For ACP Contractors

ACP Contractors are required to take OESC training to remain on the ACP Program. Those required to take training includes those individuals who install air conditioners, furnaces and/or hot water tanks, under the ACP HVAC umbrella.

The ACP Program requires that “all who do work under ACP must take New Code training, when offered”.

As HVAC OESC training sessions begin to fill, the ACP Office will be monitoring registrations to ensure all members have signed up.

As everyone is aware, HVAC ACP Contractor performance is based on ESA’s Quality Assurance Standard (QAS) and Technical defects issued on installations must be kept to a minimum. It is imperative that every HVAC ACP Contractor understands the changes to the OESC and is clear on how to do compliant installations, to avoid the issuance of Technical defects.
