



Evolution to Risk-Based Oversight

What LDCs Need to Know

Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) is responsible for the oversight of electrical work in Ontario and is moving to a risk-based approach for the oversight of electrical wiring by 2020. This means ESA will dedicate more effort on higher risk electrical wiring work, and less effort on lower risk work, without compromising safety.

Risk-based Oversight (RBO) means that ESA will use risk criteria to determine what wiring work requires a site visit. All electrical contractors will operate under this system in early 2020. Once RBO is implemented, ESA will no longer offer the Authorized Contractor Program (ACP).
