

***CSA International Announces Voluntary Recall by DEWALT® Industrial Tool Co. to Upgrade DW872 Type 1 Multi-Cutters***

Toronto, Ontario -- CSA International is announcing a voluntary recall by DEWALT® Industrial Tool Co., of Towson, Md., to upgrade about 100 model number DW872 Type 1 Multi-Cutters. The positive drive system on the saw prevents the blade from slipping which creates the potential for the work piece to come loose from the vise jaw and fence and may present a possible risk of personal injury.

DEWALT has not received any reports of injuries with these saws in Canada. This voluntary recall is being conducted to help prevent the possibility of injury.

The saws are Model Number DW872 Type 1, which is written on the nameplate. The saws are yellow with black accents. The recalled saws have date codes from 199830 through 200008, which are located on the motor end cap.

These saws were sold through some distributors in Canada from 1998 through January 2000.

Consumers should stop using these saws immediately, and contact DEWALT to arrange for an upgrade of the unit to a Type 2 free of charge. Consumers who have the unit upgraded will also receive a free blade.
