## **UL Warns Consumers About Potentially Hazardous Air Fresheners**

**NORTHBROOK, Ill., Dec. 13, 2004** -- Underwriters Laboratories Inc. (UL) is notifying consumers that air fresheners manufactured by Chuan HWA Art Industry Co., Ltd. may pose a risk of fire or electric shock.

**Name of Product:** Models AN-01 (Gardenia), AN-02 (Snowman), AN-03 (Rose)

**Units:** Unknown quantity

**Manufacturer:** Chuan HWA Art Industry Co., Ltd.

**Date of Manufacture:** November 2002 through September 2004. The date code consists of a four-digit code representing the month and year of manufacture. For example, the code 01/04 represents January 2004.

**Hazard:** UL's investigation of this product has revealed that the scented oil could flow into the wall outlet, which poses a risk of fire and electric shock.

**Identification:** The air fresheners are constructed of ceramic, shaped as a snowman, gardenia or rose. The units are marked with the Model "AN-01," "AN-02" or "AN-03," the UL file number "E180130," the manufacturer's name "Chuan HWA Art Industry Co., Ltd.," and the UL Listing Mark for the United States and Canada.

**What You Should Do:** UL recommends that users stop using the air fresheners immediately and return them to the place of purchase.
