## Lighted Mirror Sold at Wal-Mart Recalled for Shock Hazard

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed.

**Name of Product:** Simply Basic Lighted Mirror

**Units:** About 110,000

**Importer:** Wal-Mart Stores Inc., of Bentonville, Ark.

**Hazard:** Exposed wires inside the mirror could pose an electrical shock hazard to the user when they touch the mirror.

**Incidents/Injuries:** None reported.

**Description and Models:** The recalled mirror is double-sided, lighted, and has three touch control settings. It has

a metal stand with a brushed silver-colored finish. The mirror is 6.5 inches in diameter and has regular side and a magnified side. Model number DK-00118/H-1698-0 is on the bottom of the mirror's base. "Touch lighting with 3 settings" is printed on a white sticker on the top of the mirror's base.

**Sold Exclusively at:** Wal-Mart stores nationwide from August 2005 through April 2006 for about \$15.

**Manufactured In:** China

**Remedy:** Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled mirror and return it to Wal-Mart for a full refund.
