## Easy Lite Recalled for Shock or Fire Hazard

- **Product name, brand, model and serial numbers including a photo, if available:** Model # F-2RID sold under Easy Lite brand name.
- **What prompted the non-compliance notification and what conditions occur with the product:** Intertek had received 1 (one) complaint about this model overheating.
- **Name of the Certification body:** Intertek Testing (ITS)
- **Stores or retailers in Canada where the product was sold:** Home Centers and Lighting Specialty stores.
- **Approximate number of units sold in Canada:** 12,000 pcs.
- **Country of Manufacture:** China
- **A description of the non-compliances with the product. What can happen under worst case failure of the product, i.e. is it a potential fire or shock hazard :** it has been observed that during temperature test, branch circuit and mounting surface temperatures exceed the limits imposed by UL 1598/CSA 250.0 (90 deg C) which may possess a minimal potential risk of fire.
- **How many incidents have been reported:** 1 (one).
- **What steps have been taken or will be taken to notify the consumers and retailers, such as the recall notice being posted at all retail locations, notification to all retailers where the product may have been sold and copy of the recall notice sent to the Canadian Newswire or other media:** As per ITS advice, the only step should be taken is to inform CACES about this issue.
- **What should the consumer do with the product, return to point of purchase or to the retailer:** consumers should call 1-800-660-5391 for free replacement.
