Desk Lamp Recalled by Environment Lighting Concepts

Environmental Lighting Concepts of Tampa, Florida is voluntarily recalling approximately 180 desk lamps sold in Canada.

Name of Product: Taylor Desk Lamp

Units: About 180

Manufacturer: Environmental Lighting Concepts Inc., of Tampa, Fla.

Hazard: The fiberglass sheath intended to protect the electrical cord can become improperly aligned during consumer assembly of the lamp. This poses a shock hazard to consumers.

Incidents/Injuries: Environmental Lighting Concepts Inc. has received four reports of minor electrical shocks. No property damage has been reported.

Description: This recall involves “Taylor” model burnished nickel metal desk lamp. The adjustable lamp is

a metal design in burnished nickel with height adjustments from 16” to 24.75” and with articulating adjustments at the base, mid-shaft and shade. An “O” logo is engraved on the tube cup under the rotary power switch and the name “OTT-LITE” is on the front of the base.

Sold at: The recalled lamp was only sold at two (2) Costco Wholesale locations in Ontario from April 2006 to June 2006.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the lamp and return to your nearest Costco Wholesale location for a full refund.
