Currey & Company Recalls Lamps Due to Shock, Fire Hazards

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed.

The recalled table lamps include model numbers 6037, 6038, 6039, 6040, 6043, 6044, 6045, 6046, 6047, 6048, 6632, 6633, 6685, 6913, and 6954. The model number is printed on the packaging and on the bottom of the lamp base. A Currey & Company hang tag was attached to the lamp at the time of sale.

Name of product: Currey & Company Table Lamps

Sold at: Specialty stores, lighting showrooms and through interior designers from April 2006 through January 2007 for between \$240 and \$420.

Units: About 1,500

Manufactured in: China

Distributor: Currey & Company, of Atlanta, Ga.

Hazard: The light sockets on these lamps have a defect, which poses electrical shock and fire hazards.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using these lamps, and contact Currey & Company to determine if they are included in the recall. The firm will arrange for the return of the recalled lamps for a free repair.

Incidents/Injuries: Currey & Company has received one report of a lamp tripping the circuit breaker. No injuries or property damage have been reported.
