## Liteline Corporation Recalls Plastic Hardwire Switch Boxes for Potential Fire Hazard

**Toronto** – August 17, 2007 – In cooperation with CSA International, Liteline Corporation is announcing an important consumer safety alert regarding plastic hardwire switch box. Consumers should stop using the affected units immediately.

**Name of Product:** Plastic Hardwire Switch Box.

**Units:** Unknown.

**Importer:** Liteline Corporation

**Hazard:** This switch box poses a potential fire hazard and bears counterfeit (unauthorized) registered trademarks belonging to CSA International. An investigation by CSA International has revealed that this switch box does not meet the flame test requirements of the applicable standard and does not comply with the Canadian Electrical Code.

**Incidents/Injuries:** Unknown.

**Description:** The hardwire switch box is white plastic and measures 10 cm x 5 cm x 3 cm. It has a small toggle switch on the surface and short white cord with connector. The switch box is marked only with the CSA certification trademark which appears in black on a label. The switch box is identified as Cat. No. FBT6300-WH only on the Liteline Corp. website.

**Sold at:** Various electrical outlets and home centres in Canada.

**Manufactured in:** China

**Remedy:** Consumers should stop using this switch box immediately and discard or return it to their retailer or distributor. Liteline Corporation is located at 8 Abacus Road, Brampton, ON. L6T 5B7.
