The Electrical Safety Authority Is Notifying the Public that Marie-Anne Novelties, Inc. Announces Voluntary Recall of Animated Novelty Lamps

Toronto, ON – November 16, 2007 The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Marie-Anne Novelties has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer products. Consumers should stop using the recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Animated Novelty Lamps. Animated Novelty Lamps are table top or wall hung types with rotating motion showing animated fish or dolphins in an aquarium or animated racing cars.

Manufacturer/Importer: Marie-Anne Novelties

Hazard: These products may overheat and present a fire hazard.

Incidents/Injuries: New Brunswick electrical inspection body reported an incident involving an animated novelty lamp that resulted in a fire in a child’s bedroom.

Description/Models: *See the table below.*

Sold by: Hart Stores in Ontario, Quebec and the Maritimes.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using these animated novelty lamps and return them, together with their proof of purchase from Hart Stores to any Hart Store for a full refund.

Remarks: Although the packages of these lamps are printed, "CSA LL 109448 Listed in the wire", these lamps have not been certified by the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) and bear an unauthorized CSA trade mark.
