Euro-Pro Operating Recalls Deep Fryers Due to Risk of Fire and Shock

Toronto, ON – The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Euro-Pro Operating has announced a voluntary recall of the Bravetti Stainless Steel Deep Fryer. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Bravetti Stainless Steel Deep Fryer (3 basket model).

Units: Approximately 37,771 units sold in Canada including 15,100 units sold in Ontario.

Manufacturer/Importer: Euro-Pro Operating LLC, West Newton, MA 02445.

Hazard: Some customers have reported overheating and melting of the plastic base of the unit. This has the potential to damage counter-top surfaces.

Incidents/Injuries: Several reports of melting of the plastic base and heat discoloration to counter-top surfaces. No injuries have been reported.

Description/Models: Rectangular stainless steel fryer with black plastic base and lid (lid with glass window), Model F1053B.

Sold by: Sold exclusively by Canadian Tire for \$69.99 unless sold during in-store promotions for \$49.50.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the fryers immediately and return them to Canadian Tire for a full refund.
