Streamlight Inc. Recall Flashlight Model ProPolymer 4AA LED

Toronto, ON – The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Streamlight, Inc. has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. This notice concerns products manufactured prior to May 2007 only.

Name of Product: Streamlight 4AA ProPolymer LED Flashlight.

Units: - 3911 approx. affected units in Ontario.
 - 48924 approx. affected units in Canada.

Manufacturer/Importer: Streamlight, Inc.

Hazard: Several units have become hot upon initial use causing smoke, charring and melting of components which may result in a burn, fire or explosion hazard if occurring within a potentially hazardous atmosphere.

Incidents/Injuries: None reported in Canada. Four reported instances in United States. No damage/injuries.

Description/Models: “Streamlight 4AA” with “LED modules 68211, 68222 and 68223” appearing on UL and cUL panel shown on reverse side. The flashlight uses four size “AA” alkaline or carbon zinc batteries and is approved for use in Class I, Division 1, Groups C&D (US only); Class I, Division 2 Groups A,B,C,D; Class II,

division 2, Groups F and G, and Class III Hazardous (Classified) locations.

Sold by: Streamlight, Inc through distributors and retailers

When distributed: From July 11 2002 to April 24 2007.

Manufactured in: U.S.A.

Remedy: Affected units that were purchased prior to May 2007, as identified by purchase date, should be returned to the factory for replacement. Unpackaged product can be identified by date code (mm yy) appearing on flat area in threaded portion of housing under the face cap.
