DeVilbiss Recalls Air Compressors Due to Fire Hazard

Toronto, ON – The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that DeVilbiss Air Power Company has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Air compressors

Units: Approximately 8,901 in Canada.

Manufacturer/Importer: DeVilbiss Air Power Company

Hazard: The air compressor motor can overheat, posing a fire hazard.

Incidents/Injuries: DeVilbiss has received nine reports of motors overheating, including three reports of fire damage to surrounding property. No injuries have been reported.

Description/Models: The recalled compressors were sold under the Craftsman and Delta Shopmaster brand names. The Craftsman brand compressors involved in this recall are models 919-72412, 919-724121, 919-724122, and 919-72413. The Sears Craftsman brand compressors have a red 15 gallon tank. The Delta Shopmaster brand compressors involved in this recall are model CP503. The model CP503 compressors have a gray 12 gallon horizontal tank. The model number and manufacture date on each unit is located on the unit name plate on the tank.

Sold by: Craftsman brand compressors were sold at Sears Canada. Delta Shopmaster brand compressors were sold at home center, hardware, and discount stores in Canada.

When was distributed: Craftsman brand compressors were sold from approximately September 2001 to June 2006. Delta Shopmaster brand compressors were sold from approximately June 2002 to March 2003.

Manufactured in: United States

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using and unplug the recalled compressors and call DeVilbiss or Sears for a free inspection and repair.
