Camsing Global LLC recalls LED Night Lights

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Camsing Global LLC, formerly known as Corvest Acquisition Inc. has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: LED Night Lights

Units: 500 units from Ontario.

Importer/Distributor: Camsing Global LLC imported the products from China to the US which were then sold to Staples Promotional in Canada. Trane then distributed the products to their customers.

Hazard: Overheating, smoldering or melting of product when plugged into an electrical outlet.

Incidents/Injuries: Five incidents of the product overheating, smoldering or melting when plugged into an electrical outlet. There have been no physical injuries or property damage reported.

Description/Models: LED night light, which is fire retardant and measures about 1 ¾ inches wide and by 3 ¾ inches high, has a white bulb with a clear bulb cover.

Model SBD01, the number E314462 and “China” are stamped on the back of the product’s white base.

Distributed by: Trane as a free promotional product for their customers, imprinted with the company's name.

When was distributed: January 20, 2011 – June 27, 2011.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should contact Camsing for instructions for returning of product.
