Canadian Tire Corporation Recalls Mastercraft Digital Clamp Meter

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Mastercraft Digital Clamp Meter, identified by product number 52-0163.

Units: Approximately 21,573 units were sold in Canada.

Manufacturer: Colluck Company Limited.

Importer: Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited.

Hazard: Canadian Tire is recalling the Mastercraft Digital Clamp Meter as a precautionary safety measure due to improper wiring within the product on some units which could lead to an inaccurate reading.

Incidents/Injuries: Canadian Tire has not received any reports of incidents or injuries related to the use of these affected meters.

Description/Models: This recall involves the Mastercraft Digital Clamp Meter identified by product number 52-0163. The digital meter is a hand-held device with a 1.9

centimeter (3/4 inch) LCD display and plastic yellow clamps on the end. The 'Mastercraft' brand name is located on the front of the device and the product is sold with black and red test leads.

Sold by: Canadian Tire.

When was distributed: The recalled products were sold from October 2007 to October 2011.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers are asked to contact the Mastercraft hotline to verify whether their product is affected by this recall. If consumers have an affected product, they should discontinue using the digital clamp meter and return it to any Canadian Tire store for a refund.
