Traeger BBQ Canada East Recalls Pellet Grills

Toronto, ON – The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Traeger Pellet Grills has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using the recalled product immediately and contact Traeger BBQ Canada East at the number listed below for further instructions.

Name of Product: Traeger Pellet Grills

Units: Approximately 4,000 sold in Canada

Importer: Traeger BBQ Canada East

Hazard: The affected products have not been tested to determine whether they are compliant with the Canadian Standards for product safety and may pose a hazard.

Incidents/Injuries: None reported.

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the recalled products immediately and contact Traeger Canada East at 866-415-8159. Traeger Canada East will arrange for a product inspection by an authorized third party free of charge.

Description/Models: These products are Traeger Pellet Grills' model numbers BBQ055 – aka. Traeger Junior Grill, BBQ070 – aka. Traeger Lil' Tex, BBQ07E – aka. Lil' Tex Elite, BBQ075 – aka. Texas and BBQ300 – aka. Traeger Deluxe.

These are pellet BBQ grills used for grilling and cooking food. They are black in colour and have a round barrel shaped body. Model numbers BBQ070, BBQ07E and BBQ075 have a chimney which extends from the right side of the grill as you are facing it from the front.

BBQ300 is also black in colour with stainless steel trim, cabinet doors beneath the cooking area and one stainless steel shelf on each side of the main body.
