Bel Air Lighting Recalls Nine Light Chandeliers Due to Impact Injury Hazard

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Bel Air Lighting Inc. has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

Name of Product: Portfolio Nine Light Chandelier

Units: 1540 in Canada.

Manufacturer: Pascal, Bai Yun Shan Industrial Zone, Chen Jiang Town Hui Yang City. Guang Dong, China.

Importer: Bel Air Lighting Inc., Valencia, Calif.

Hazard: The mounting loop that connects the chandelier to the ceiling can fail during use, causing the chandelier to fall and creating a risk of injury to individuals under or near the chandelier.

Incidents/Injuries: Seventeen reports of chandeliers falling from ceilings. No reports of injuries have been received.

Description/Models: The product is a nine-light chandelier, Lowe's item number 256047 sold under

the Portfolio brand and as Transglobe item 2579 EBG. The chandelier metal is antique bronze colored and the glass light shades are frosted yellow.

Sold by: Lowe's stores under the Portfolio brand (item 256047); in lighting showrooms as item 2579 EBG for \$250.

When was distributed: March 2007 through September 2012.

Manufactured in: China

Remedy: Consumers should contact Bel Air to receive a free replacement mounting ring and reimbursement of installation costs if necessary.
