**MKE Industries Recalls Commercial Electrical Fryer Model FE-16M (A,B,C,D) Due to Potential Fire Hazard**

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that MKE Industries has announced a voluntary recall of the following commercial product. Users should stop using recalled products immediately.

**Name of Product:** Electric Fryer**Units:** 100 units**Manufacturer/Importer:** MKE Industries**Manufactured in:** Canada

**Hazard:** The temperature probes in the unit are located in different positions than those on the unit that underwent safety certification. If the unit is used with a small amount of oil (just enough to reach the bottom elements) there is a risk that the oil will ignite.

**Incidents/Injuries:** No incidents reported.

**Description/Models:** All FE-16M that have been manufactured between 2010 and 2014.

**Sold by:** Canadian commercial kitchen equipment distributors

**When distributed:** Between 2010 and 2014

**Remedy:** A technician will be sent on site to repair the unit.
