The Electrical Safety Authority Warns Consumers about Unapproved Whole Body Vibration Plate Type Fitness Equipment: “T-Zone” & “Crazy Fit”

These products are unapproved, not tested to any Canadian Safety Standards and do not bear any recognized certification mark in Canada. They bear an unauthorized UL / cUL Mark. Those products with a CSA Mark are not included in this Safety Alert.

Description/Models: Sold under “T-ZONE” and Crazy Fit” brand names in North America. Model numbers are: FT-F105, FT-F105N and VT-7
