ESA Warns Consumers of Unsafe Power Strips distributed by Lush Life

The Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) is notifying retailers and consumers about unsafe power strips being distributed by Lush Life. The power strips have undersized wiring which poses a risk of shock to consumers. In addition, the wiring and plastic strip fail to meet fire resistance safety standards, posing a fire hazard to consumers.
