**Canarm LTD. Recalls Ceiling Lights Due to Shock or Fire Hazard**

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that Canarm Ltd. has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

**Name of Product:** Semi Flush ceiling light (Twenty One Collection)

**Units:** 4,225 units

**Importer:** Canarm Ltd.

**Manufactured in:** China

**Hazard:** When the unit is being mounted, it is possible for the consumer to screw in the main mounting stud too far which can result in damage to the protective coating on internal wires causing a potential fire or shock hazard.

**Incidents/Injuries:** One report confirmed. A customer complained that the stem pinched electrical wires causing a shock to the consumer.

**Description/:** Semi Flush ceiling light model number ISF253A03ORB.

**Sold by:** Home Hardware Stores across Canada.

**When distributed:** Between 2010 and 2012.

**Remedy:** Consumers should stop using the ceiling lights immediately and tighten the hex lock nut provided to prevent stem from contacting electrical wire or call for new replacement stem which does not require locking nut.
