**LEM Products Distribution Recalls 5 Tray Dehydrator Due to Fire Hazard**

The Electrical Safety Authority is notifying the public that LEM Products Distribution has announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately.

**Name of Product:** 5 Tray Dehydrator

**Units:** Approximately 107 sold in Canada.

**Importer:** LEM Products Distribution

**Manufactured in:** China

**Hazard:** If the fan on the unit does not operate, the unit may overheat, posing a fire hazard.

**Incidents/Injuries:** LEM Products Distribution has received two reports in the U.S. of motor failure, resulting in a fire in the unit.

**Description/Models:** This recall involves 5-tray LEM food dehydrators, with model number 1009. The dehydrators are gray and are made of plastic and metal. The LEM logo is embossed on the top of the unit. The

model number is located on the label on the back panel. The UPC code found on the bottom of the packaging reads 734494010091.

**When distributed:** August 2010 through February 2013.

**Remedy:** Consumers should immediately stop using the dehydrator and contact LEM Products Distribution for instructions on free shipping and repair of the recalled product.
